4. ENTRIES

4.1 CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES

Tuesday, 7 May 2024 at 14:00h CET.

4.2 ENTRY PROCEDURE

4.2.1 Anyone wishing to take part in the 15 Historic Rally of Asturias must use the **FIA Online Registration Platform**.

All crews who wish to score points in the EHRC must make their entries by using the standard entry form for their championship available in the FIA application at: <https://registrations.fia.com/EHRC>

4.2.2 Any other crews who are not registered in the EHRC and who are therefore not wishing to collect points in the EHRC, must use and send the entry form available at https://registrations.fia.com/EHRC_3ESP duly completed before the closing date of entries.

Please note that the FIA registration platform requires a user ID and a password to access the entry system. Please do not wait until the last moment to make your entry in order not to miss the entry closing date.

4.2.3 Acceptance of Entry Form

The entry application will only be accepted if duly completed and accompanied by the bank transfer of the total amount of the entry fee to the Organiser's bank account.

4.2.4 National/International License Equivalence

Competition Licences delivered by the RFEDA have the same value as an International Licences for the rally.

Note: Drivers and Co-drivers wishing to score points in the FIA EHRC must participate in the rally with International Competition Licences *only*.

4.3 NUMBER OF COMPETITORS ACCEPTED AND CLASSES

4.3.1 The maximum number of entries accepted will be 100. FIA EHRC registered drivers will be given priority for approved entries, after which the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which entries among the non-FIA EHRC registered drivers will be accepted.

4.3.2 Cars eligible to enter the event

4.4 ENTRY FEES

4.6 REFUNDS

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- a) To candidates whose entry has not been accepted.
- b) In the case of the rally not taking place.

(Organisers may refund 80% of the entry fee to the competitors who, for reasons of “force majeure”, duly certified by their ASN, were unable to start in the rally).

5. INSURANCE

The organiser provides the following insurance: Zurich Insurance PLC Sucursal en España.

Insurance cover: as Law 21/2007, mandatory car insurance:

For personal injuries: up to 70 million euros per claim.

For property damage: up to 15 million euros per claim.

Insurance cover will come into effect from the start and will cease at the end of the Rally or at the moment of withdrawal or disqualification of the Competitor.

6. ADVERTISING & IDENTIFICATION

All advertising or sponsorship of tobacco products on clothing, complements, instruments, equipment, prototypes and/or vehicles of teams participating in motor sports competitions or events is banned by law. See also FIA International Sporting Code Articles 10.6.2 and 12.2.1.n

7. TYRES

7.1 NUMBER OF TYRES & TYRE MARKING PROCEDURE

7.1.1 Eligible tyres

All tyres used for rally stages on tarmac and road sections must be marked «E» or «DOT» in accordance with the appropriate standard of the country in which the Competition is taking place. They must have a minimum external diameter corresponding to the period in question (see Article 8.4.2 of Appendix K) and they must not be marked «*Not for highway use*» nor «*For Racing Only*» nor imply any indication limiting, specifying or recommending a use in competition. Any alteration, modification or adaptation (which for the avoidance of doubt includes cutting of additional grooves) of tyres other than wear through normal use is forbidden. For stages run on gravel, and so declared by the clerk of the course, no «E» or «DOT» tyre marking is necessary.

a) Cars of Category 1: During Competitions classed as tarmac event (i.e. excluding gravel or snow Competitions) there shall be **a maximum of 14 tyres permitted**. Tyres must be uniquely identified with a barcode (or such other method as may be prescribed) and registered with the FIA eligibility delegate before the start of the Competition. Checks for compliance with this regulation may be undertaken at any time during the Competition and any discrepancies will be reported to the stewards. A detailed information sheet will be available before each Competition.



b) Cars of Category 2, 3 and 4: During Competitions classed as tarmac (i.e. excluding gravel or snow Competitions) there shall be **a maximum of 10 tyres said «dry» permitted**. Tyres must be uniquely identified with a barcode (or such other method as may be prescribed) and registered with the FIA eligibility delegate before the start of the Competition. Due to the lack of availability of «wet» tyres in their appropriate sizes, the cars listed as exceptions in the appendix to the FIA authorized wet tyre list may register a maximum of 14 tyres before the start of the Competition. **Thus there is no allowance for additional «wet» tyres.**

Checks for compliance with this regulations may be undertaken at any time during the Competition and any discrepancies will be reported to the stewards. The number of «wet» tyres is not limited. Only the «wet» tyres as per the FIA authorised tyre list can be used. A detailed information sheet will be available before each Competition.

7.1.2 Tyre marking is obligatory for all the competitors.

All tyres must have a specific barcode number supplied by the 2024 FIA-approved barcode supplier. All tyres must be registered with the FIA Eligibility delegate before the start of the rally, at pre-event scrutineering. The cars must be presented at the tyre Marking Zone with their spare wheels placed with the outer part of the rim on top, and if needed, unfastened, to facilitate the procedure. Following the marking, and before the cars departure from the tyre marking area, crews, or their team member, must properly fasten the spare wheels as required. For Competitors taking part in the Shakedown (where offered by the event), tyres used for the Shakedown will not be marked.

7.1.3 Tyre Marking during the rally

A wheel/tyre marking / barcode reading zone may be established at the exit of the authorised service parks or remote service zones and at the start of a stage. The crew has to stop its car and wait for the instructions of the scrutineers and/or marshal. In the absence of scrutineers or marshals, the crew may leave the zone without stopping. A tyre mark checking zone may be established at the entrance of the authorised service parks and remote service zones.

7.1.4 Means of control.

Checks for compliance with this regulation may be undertaken at any time during the rally and any discrepancies will be reported to the stewards. A detailed information sheet will be available before each rally.

7.2 TYRES USED FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Only E- or DOT-approved homologated road legal tyres are allowed. Retreaded tyres are forbidden for reconnaissance. Any treatment (ie. removing or damaging) on road tyres side markings or texts is not allowed.

7.3 NATIONAL LAWS OR SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

8. SERVICE AND FUEL

8.1 SERVICE – GENERAL CONDITIONS

All services made on the car for the duration of the rally must be made in accordance with the EHRC Sporting Regulations, Article 56.

8.2.3 Procedure in Remote Service Zones

The time for servicing in the Remote Service Zones is included in the sector time.

For safety reasons, refuelling is strictly forbidden in ALL Remote Service Zones.

8.3 FUEL RESTRICTIONS

It is mandatory for participants to use Fuel in accordance with FIA Appendix K Article 3.9.

8.4 REFUELLING

8.4.1 All Competitors may only refuel in a Refuelling Zone (RZ) as indicated in the Road Book.

Competitors cars may be refuelled from drums/cans with commercially available fuel and two team members with team passes may access the RZ to assist each crew. In order to access the refuelling zone, team personnel must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, a balaclava and gloves.

According to EHRC Sporting Regulations - Article 61.2.4 each competitor will be responsible to use environmental mats to protect the ground while the cars are refuelling. **Under no circumstances can the competing crew remain in the vehicle during ANY refuelling operations.**

The Official Refuelling Zone will be located 750 meters after the exit of the Service Park at:

8.4.2 Refuelling in a commercial filling station

Refuelling in the commercial filling stations which appear in the published Road Book is permitted.

8.4.3 Refuelling procedure

The complete refuelling procedure must be in compliance with Article 61.2 of the FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations. The competitors are responsible for using an environmental mat to protect the ground in the official refuelling zone. *These are not provided by the organisers. The refuelling mat is not a requirement when taking fuel from a commercial filling station directly from the pump.*

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION

Reconnaissance registration will take place as follows:

9.4 RECONNAISSANCE RULES

The crews are obliged to follow all reconnaissance rules specified in FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

9.4.1 Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance will be organised in compliance with art. 35 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations and only series production cars conforming to art. 35.1 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations must be used.

9.4.2 Speed limit (Art. 34.2 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations):

The maximum speeds set for the reconnaissance are the speed limit signs/rules of the road in each case, specially remarked on built-up areas (30 km/h or 50 km/h).

9.4.3 Direction

Each crew may drive the Special Stages *only in the direction of the rally*. The crews must always enter and leave the Special Stages through the start and stop controls.



9.4.4 Restriction of reconnaissance

Not applicable.

9.4.5 Number of persons on board

During each passage through a Special Stage, the crew only (2) is permitted in the car.

9.4.6 Number of passages

The number of passages is free.

9.4.7 Illegal reconnaissance

Not applicable.

9.4.8 Speeding

Speeding will be penalized according to the Art. 34.2 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations.

Speeding during reconnaissance will incur a fine applied by the clerk of the course as follows - per km per hour over the speed limit: **€25**.

The fine will be doubled in case of a second offence committed during reconnaissance.

9.4.9 Radar detection equipment

The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment during reconnaissance is not permitted.

Infringements will be reported to the stewards.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKING

10.1 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED

At Administrative Checking the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified:

- Competitor's licence
- Driver and Co-driver competition licences
- Driver and Co-driver valid driving licence
- ASN authorisation (mandatory for all foreign Competitors and/or Drivers)
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Valid personal accident insurance of non-EU Drivers
- Car registration papers
- Valid car's FIA HTP

11. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1 SCRUTINEERING VENUE AND TIMETABLE

Venue: I.E.S. Pravia. C/ Martinez de Tena sn, 33120 – Pravia (Asturias)

Date: Thursday 16 May from 17:30 to 20:00

The detailed timetable for pre-rally scrutineering will be published in a Bulletin.

Any crew taking part in the rally (or their representative) must arrive at the Scrutineering and present the car in accordance with the timetable to be issued in a Bulletin. **Any lateness entering to pre-rally Scrutineering area will be sanctioned with a fine of €30 for each 10 minutes delayed.** Drivers and Co-drivers are not required to attend Scrutineering.

The cars must be fully prepared and ready for all necessary sealing and marking (Art 16.1.2 FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations), (if the car is not prepared for the sealing, the car will not be authorized to access to the Scrutineering and fine for lateness will be applicable):

- Compressor (turbocharger) and the spare one for all compressor equipped cars;
- The dismantled underbody protectors must be kept with the car weight checks.
- Sealing wires must be installed according to the instructions given at a later date.

Documents to be presented at scrutineering:

- Vehicle registration document, when it's applicable;
- power of attorney from the owner of the car, if he/she is not one of the Drivers;
- Valid vehicle insurance policy (e.g. Green Card);
- **Vehicle original FIA HTP.** In addition, homologation form for rollcage/ROPS (if homologated) must be with the car at Scrutineering.

The crew must present the FIA HTP to the FIA eligibility delegate who will keep it until the end of the event. If this is not provided, the car may not start in the FIA EHRC section of the rally or be eligible to score any points in FIA EHRC.

11.2 CREW MEMBERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

At Scrutineering Competitors must produce all items of protective clothing, underwear, including helmets and a FIA approved head restraint (FHR, formerly called HANS) intended to be used. In 2024, all fireproof underwear must have an FIA hologram. Fireproof socks must be FIA 8856-2000 or FIA 8856-2018 certified – *but a hologram may not be present on all socks*. Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked. The use of FHR in Category 1 is recommended but not mandatory. Any infringement will be penalised by the stewards.

The use of driver's safety equipment may be checked at any time and must be worn correctly **at all times** between the start of the special stage and the special stage STOP line.

11.3 INSTALLATION OF SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

The tracking system will be fitted to the cars during Scrutineering by a marshal.

In case of withdrawal the tracking system must be returned to Rally HQ.

At the end of the rally, the tracking system will be dismantled by a marshal at the Parc Fermé entrance.



12. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 CEREMONIAL START PROCEDURE

Ceremonial Start procedure:

The ceremonial start will be held at the same time as the Start of Leg1 on the Rally Podium.

12.2 FINISH PROCEDURE

The cars will enter Parc Fermé and remain within it once the competition has finished. Selected cars must be driven to the Final Scrutineering by the driver or mechanic.

At 20:00h, the Prize-Giving will take place in the podium. Award winners must attend.

12.3 PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN

Crews are authorised to check-in early without time penalty at:

TC4A (Friday) and TC10A (Saturday)

12.4 START PROCEDURE AND ORDER

12.4.1 Starting order and intervals

The start order will be according to Article 41 of the FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations. The interval between each car will be 1 minute.

12.4.2 Start procedure for Special Stages

Start Procedure for Special Stages will be as follows:

A start clock with countdown will be placed in the start line. This start clock will be linked to a cell beam located 50 cm after the start line.

12.4.3 Re-start after retirement / Catch-up

Re-start will be allowed under all provisions applied in Article 54 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations.

Any crew which has failed to complete Leg 1 can re-start the rally from the start of Leg 2 unless they confirm otherwise to the Clerk of the Course prior to the publication of the start list of Leg 2 on Friday 17 May 2024 at 23:00.

The restarting car must report to the overnight Parc Fermé prior to Leg 2, on Saturday 18 May 2024 at 08:00. The re-scrutineering of cars will take place at no later than 08:30 at the Parc Fermé.

12.5 REMOVAL OF CARS FROM THE FINAL PARC FERMÉ

Cars may be removed from final Parc Fermé once the Stewards authorise its opening. Provided that the above takes place as scheduled, all cars must be removed no later than 09:00 on Sunday 19 May 2024.

12.6 OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY

Throughout the rally, the official time will be the GPS official time.

12.7 TIME CARDS

12.7.1. New time cards will be issued to the Competitors at the following time controls:

- **Parc Fermé Exit 15 minutes before start time, and in TC 2B, TC 4B and TC 7B.**



12.7.2. Upon retiring, a crew must hand in its time card either to a marshal at a time Control or to the sweeping car.

12.8 PROCEDURE TO ENTER START PARK – PARC FERME

The Start Park-Parc Fermé will be open from: Thursday 11th May, from the start of the scrutineering until 21:00h, and on Friday 12th May from 10:00h until its deadline indicated on the programme of the rally (13:30h).

12.9 EMERGENCY CONTACT

15.1 Final Scrutineering

Competitors who will be selected for final Scrutineering are requested to provide proper equipment (including all sealed spare parts) and mechanics at the Final Scrutineering venue.

Each selected car will be driven to Final Scrutineering by a designated member of the team (who must be present at the finish) and accompanied by an official. In case of a protest, the said car will be checked at the same venue.

15.2 PROTEST DEPOSIT

The protest deposit is **€1,000.00** (FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations - Art. 65.2).

In the case of protests referring to the alleged non-compliance of Automobiles with the regulations and requiring the dismantling and re-assembly of clearly defined parts of an Automobile, an additional deposit may be specified by the stewards on a proposal from the FIA Eligibility Delegate.

This additional deposit must be paid by the protester within one hour upon notification of the stewards (or, where appropriate, within such timeframe as agreed by them) otherwise, the protest will be deemed inadmissible.

15.3 APPEAL DEPOSIT

The appeal deposit for an international appeal is: **€3,000.00**

All protests and/or appeals must be lodged in accordance with Articles 13 and 15 of the Code and, where applicable, with the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.

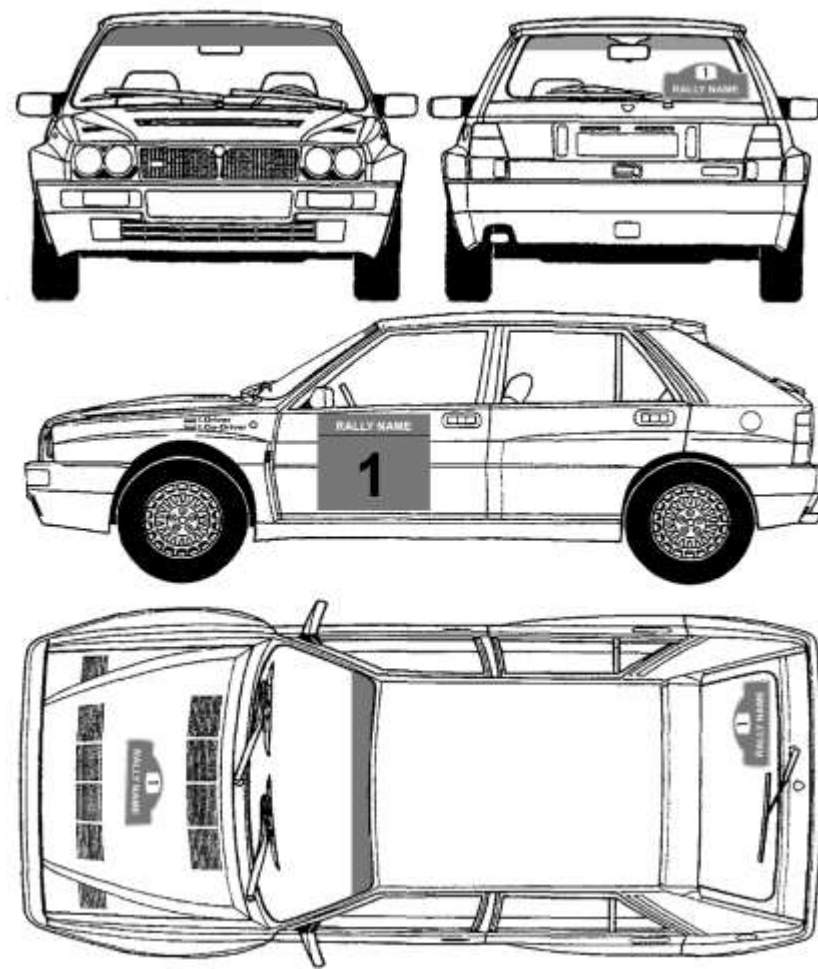

APPENDIX 4. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING



All cars must comply with the Article 2.1.9 of Appendix K.

- **Competition Numbers**

1 – door panels (2 per car): 40 cm x 40 cm

2 – rally plate (1 per car): 43 cm x 21,5 cm

3 – rear/window: 1 Competition number 7,5 cm x 15 cm

- **Optional Advertising – space reserved for Organiser’s advertising**

(2 per car, next to the door panels): 15 cm x 40 cm

(1 per car, in the upper centre of the rear window): 10 cm x 20 cm

- **Driver and Co-Driver Names**

The names of the crew plus their national flags must appear on both sides of the wings at the front of the car (max size 10cm x 40cm). Any car failing to comply with this rule shall be subject to a penalty.

- **Scrutineering Sticker** - 12 cm x 6 cm, It will be affixed in the left side.



APPENDIX 5. EXTRACTS FROM FIA APPENDIX L RELATING TO OVERALLS, HELMETS AND ANY OTHER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment. Many crash helmets have expired for International rally use in 2023!

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards for 2024:

- 8859-2015 (Technical List N°49) – No current expiry date.
- 8860-2010 (or 8860-2010 & SNELL SA 2010) (Technical List N°33) - (Not valid after 2028)
- 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP (Technical List N°69) – No current expiry date.

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858.

Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29.

See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard with an FIA hologram present on all items*, (Technical List N°27) or 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also Regional Rally Sporting Regulations, Article 53.1.

Not all fireproof socks have an FIA hologram offered by the manufacturer. Socks with FIA 8856-2000 or FIA 8856-2018 will be accepted without a hologram, subject to checking by a scrutineer. **All other items must have an FIA hologram present or they will not be accepted at scrutineering in 2024.*

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing, watches (apart from co-driver requirements) and metal neck chains is prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start, or at any location on the rally. Wedding rings are exempt.

APPENDIX 6. FIRE EXTINGUISHER EXEMPTION, FIA APPENDIX J.

In 2024, FIA Appendix J was updated, including **Article 253/7.3.1**, relating to handheld fire extinguishers.

Appendix J – Art. 253, Article 7.3.1

FIA Championships as from 01.01.2024 / Rally Cars:

All cars must be fitted with two fire extinguishers in compliance with Articles 7.3.2 to 7.3.5 hereunder or with FIA Standard 8865-2015 (Articles 7.3.2 to 7.3.5 hereunder do not apply in the latter case).

Installation of the second manual extinguisher: in accordance with Article 7.3.6 below. It can be installed in the cockpit or the luggage compartment.

As from 01.01.2024, at least one of the two compulsory manual extinguishers must be High Voltage compatible (see Article 253-18.23).

FIA Appendix K (Article 5.7.1) refers directly to Article 7.3.1 of Appendix J - Art. 253 for requirements on fire extinguishers.

Exemption from FIA Historic Department:

The above requirement for *two handheld fire extinguishers* **DOES NOT APPLY** to FIA European Historic Rally Championship events in 2024, for all competitors using historic competition vehicles in compliance with Appendix K, with a valid FIA HTP.

Only **one handheld fire extinguisher** in the vehicle is mandatory in 2024, alongside the FIA approved automatic fire system.

All fire extinguishers must be in-date and serviced correctly, in line with FIA regulations.

APPENDIX 7. INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USE OF THE GPS TRACKING SYSTEM UNIT

The SPICA III unit by Anube will be mounted in the car with its own support provided by Anube during the Technical Scrutineering with a Velcro or straps in the dashboard or in the rollcage (codriver's side). It's not necessary to provide any electrical connection to the battery to install the device.

To request immediate medical attention, or to notify that a vehicle totally blocks pass to other participants.
